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## **Guidelines for Applicants to fill sub-sections of “Required Details”**

This FAQ can be placed before the application form so that applicants clearly understand what is expected in each section.

### **1 Qualification (Weightage: 10%)**

#### **What information should be provided in this section?**

- Highest educational and professional qualifications obtained.
- Total teaching experience, current designation, and current institution.

What documents can I attach

- Degree and qualification certificates.
- Any other relevant supporting documents.

### **2 Innovation in Teaching (Weightage: 20%)**

#### **2.1 What should I write in this section?**

Describe any innovative teaching methods, ideas, or practices introduced by you.

#### **2.1 What information should be included?**

- The challenge or problem you identified.
- The solution or innovation you implemented.
- Changes or improvements achieved after implementation.
- Use of technology in teaching.
- Learning resources, curriculum, or educational content developed by you.
- Project-based, experiential, field-based, or community-based learning activities conducted.

#### **2.2 What documents can I attach?**

Lesson plans, teaching materials, innovation reports, student feedback, research papers, or evidence of innovation.

### **3 Student Impact (Weightage: 20%)**

#### **3.1 What should I write in this section?**

Explain how your teaching has positively influenced students over the years.

#### **3.2 What information should be included?**

- Major improvements in student learning and development due to your teaching.
- Success stories and achievements of students under your guidance.
- Number of students taught or mentored.
- Support provided to disadvantaged, slow learners, first-generation learners, or students with special needs.
- Evidence showing the impact of your work on students.

### **3.3 What documents can I attach?**

Student results, testimonials, achievement records, awards received by students, case studies, or any other supporting evidence.

## **4 Values and Character Development (Weightage: 10%)**

### **4.1 What should I write in this section?**

Explain how you help students become responsible, ethical, confident, and socially aware individuals.

### **4.2 What information should be included?**

- Activities promoting ethics, values, and character building.
- Efforts towards student well-being.
- Initiatives for inclusiveness, responsible digital behaviour, and conflict resolution.
- Positive behavioural changes observed among students.

### **4.3 What documents can I attach?**

Activity reports, testimonials, certificates, photographs, and any evidence of student development.

## **5 Society / Community Contribution (Weightage: 10%)**

### **5.1 What should I write in this section?**

Describe your contribution to society beyond your regular teaching responsibilities.

### **5.2 What information should be included?**

- Community service and outreach activities.
- Awareness campaigns, or social initiatives.
- Work related to youth, women, rural communities, environment, or health.
- Partnerships with NGOs, institutions, government bodies, or community organizations.
- Awards or recognition received for social contribution.

### **5.3 What documents can I attach?**

Activity reports, appreciation letters, media coverage, impact reports, certificates, and awards.

## **6 Professional Achievements (10%)**

### **6.1 What should I write in this section?**

Highlight your professional accomplishments and recognition received during your career.

### **6.2 What information should be included?**

- Major achievements during the last ten years.
- Academic leadership positions held.
- Contributions to accreditation, policy formulation, or institutional growth.

- Publications, books, patents, educational resources, or research contributions.
- Membership of professional associations.
- Invitations as speaker, trainer, examiner, expert, or resource person.

### **6.3 What documents can I attach?**

Appointment letters, publications, conference invitations, patents, copyrights, and any other supporting evidence.

## **7 Award & Recognitions (10%)**

- Awards, honours, fellowships, and recognitions received.

## **8 Vision for Future Education (Weightage: 10 %)**

### **8.1 What should I write in this section?**

Share your thoughts on the future of education and the role of teachers.

### **8.2 What information should be included?**

- Your vision for education in the coming years.
- Key reforms needed in schools and higher education.
- Suggestions for improving teaching-learning systems.
- Views on balancing technology and human values.
- Role of teachers in an AI-driven future.
- Ideas for preparing students for future opportunities and challenges.

### **8.3 What documents can I attach?**

Articles, presentations, published work, policy notes, or any relevant thought leadership material (optional).

## **9 General Advice for Applicants**

### **9.1 What kind of information is most valuable?**

Provide specific examples, measurable outcomes, and evidence wherever possible. The selection committee will look for impact, innovation, leadership, and contribution to students and society.

### **9.2 What kind of supporting documents should I submit?**

Only submit documents that directly support your achievements, impact, and claims made in the application.

### **9.3 How detailed should my responses be?**

Be concise but provide enough information for the jury to understand the significance and impact of your work.
